- ♦ Based on years of commissions for diverse ventures I am well-versed in using the Adobe Creative Suite 6 (Photoshop, InDesign, Illustrator, Dreamweaver, Premiere, AfterEffects, Audition) and software like CorelDRAW, 3ds Max, Visual Studio and Eclipse
- ♦ A good command of office suite (word processor, spread sheet, presentation software) was needed for my study
- ♦ Gained experience with HTML, CSS, PHP, C++ through designing webpages for seminars and creating games for academic projects

- ♦ Worked as part of CampusTV under a busy schedule and great pressure to retain the high quality of the TV reports
- ♦ Accustomed to group projects through various academic assignments, where three or four students elaborated a topic and created a website, short film or other media product, a high flexibility was essential to work with students from different faculties
- ♦ Being patient and empathic was indispensable as participant of the media weeks (where little groups of students taught 10 to 14 year old pupils how to use a camera and helped them to create their own short film in just one day) and also as a leader of a tutorial for elderly people (where a fellow student and I showed them how to use a photo editing software, e.g. to correct colour schemes, to remove unwanted parts)
